

Constitution

Changes to this constitution may only be made at an Annual General Meeting.

1. Name and purpose

The league is called the Demo Pool League. It exists to organise friendly, competitive pool between pubs and clubs in central London, through a league and knockout competitions.

2. Membership

1. Membership is open to any team whose venue has a suitable table and agrees to host home matches on league night.
2. Each team pays an annual subscription set at the Annual General Meeting.
3. Subscriptions are due by the end of the first month of the season. The Treasurer does not accept IOUs, promissory notes or “next week”.

3. Officers and committee

Chairman	Samuel Pickwick	Chairs meetings and represents the league
Secretary	Dr John Watson	Keeps the minutes and the league site, and writes the news
Treasurer	Ebenezer Scrooge	Keeps the accounts and collects subscriptions
Fixtures Secretary	Friar Tuck	Fixtures, postponements and results

Officers are elected each year at the Annual General Meeting and together form the committee. The committee meets regularly during the season. Three officers are a quorum.

4. Meetings

1. The Annual General Meeting is held before each season. Each team may send two representatives and has one vote.
2. Proposals for rule changes must reach the Secretary two weeks before the meeting.
3. A captains' meeting is held before the start of each season.
4. Meeting dates are published on the Committee & Information page of the league site.

5. Finances

The league's money is held in a bank account in the league's name. Two officers sign for any payment. The Treasurer presents the accounts at the Annual General Meeting.

6. Discipline

The committee may fine, suspend or expel any player or team whose conduct brings the league into disrepute. Anyone facing a hearing is given notice and may speak at it.

7. Dissolution

The league may be dissolved by a two-thirds vote at a general meeting. Any remaining funds will be given to a local charity chosen at that meeting.
